Tesco Neighbourhood Food Collection

Friday 1st and Saturday 2nd July 2016 @ Tesco Sandhurst Extra

From the 30th June to 2nd July, all UK Tesco stores will be hosting a food collection for Trussell Trust foodbanks as part of the eighth Neighbourhood Food Collection.

Crowthorne Foodbank need to provide volunteers on Friday 1st July and Saturday 2nd July, between the hours of 9am-5pm, to receive donations from customers at Tesco Sandhurst Extra at the Meadows. The summer months can be a difficult time for families who are already managing on extremely tight budgets. The lack of free school meals and the cost of funding childcare can put an additional pressure on families, with many foodbanks seeing an increase in referrals during this time.

Donations made to Trussell Trust foodbanks are used to provide 3 days of nutritionally-balanced, emergency food to people in crisis who have been referred by frontline professional agencies, such as Citizens Advice or children's centres. Whilst at the foodbank, clients will be welcomed, listened to and signposted to services that can provide support to address the underlying causes of their crisis.

Tesco top-up customer donations by making a 20% financial contribution to us, so by getting involved you'll not only help provide vital food to UK people experiencing crisis, but the Tesco donated funds will help Trussell Trust foodbanks provide important support, beyond food, to tackle the root causes of poverty.
